

# Hanley - Manual Watering

1. Ensure that the taps near the entrance to the courts are turned to the off position.

2 Remove everything from the court that you don't want to get wet.

3 Position the 2 sprinklers outside of the tram lines approximately at the level of the service line of the court you wish to water.

4 Remove the magical stone and switch on the secret tap. The magical stone is to be found on the lawn side of court one behind the deuce side of the court.

5 Go to the collection of taps near the entrance to the courts and switch on the two appropriate ones. Yes, the washers need replacing, so they leak.

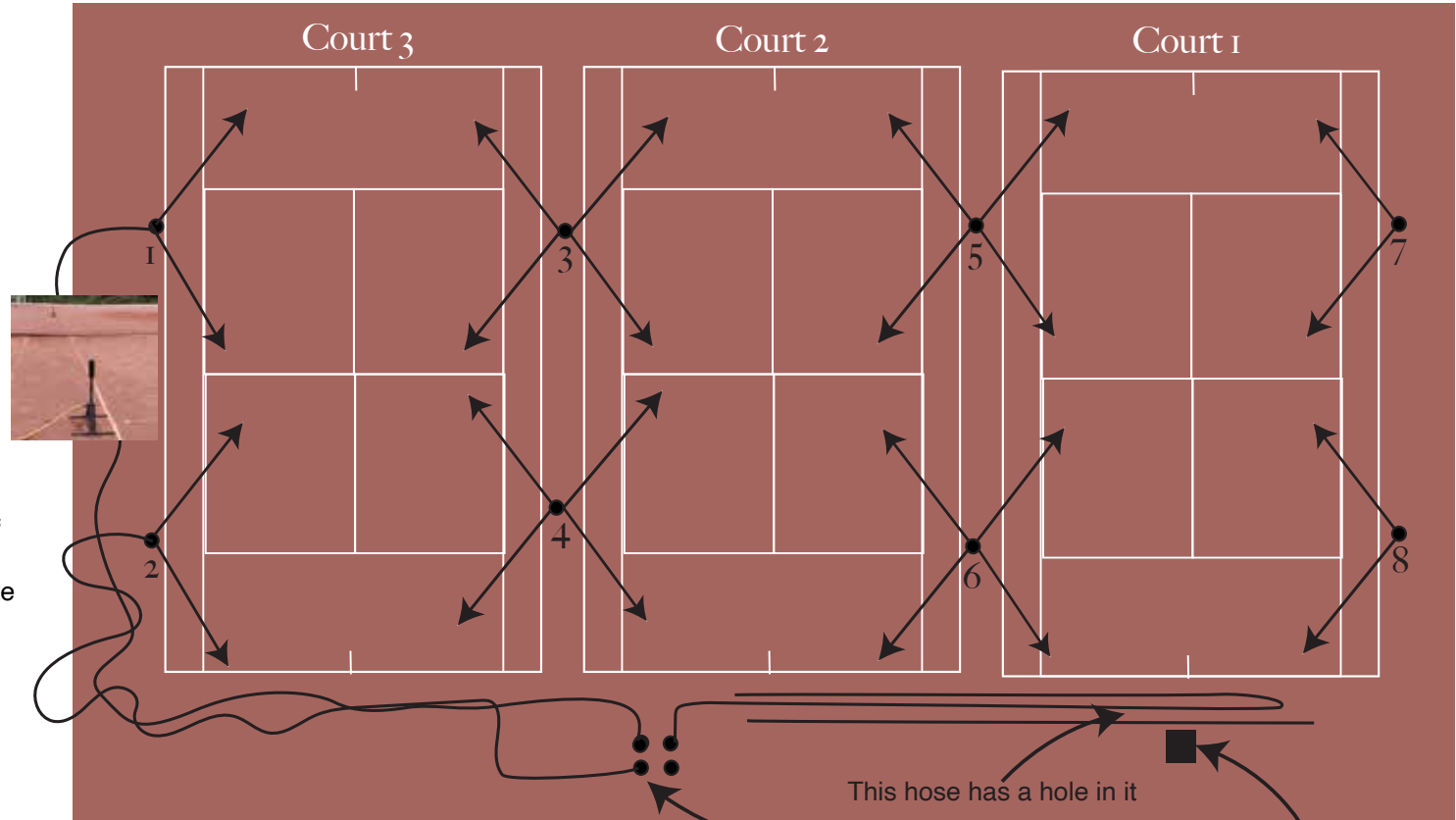
6. Usually water between 10 minutes and half an hour. Ideally, if there's time to water more thoroughly, move the sprinklers to the opposite positions on each court to get full coverage.

7 Repeat for each court you want to water.

8. Turn off the taps near the gate and then go and turn off the secret tap under the magical stone, ensuring magical stone is replaced.

9. Remove the sprinklers from the court and put them away where you found them, where there should not be a hazard to players.

The sprinklers rotate through about 180 degrees. If you put them in the marked 8 positions by the service lines, you can water half of each court at a time



There are four taps. The left two control the main two sprinklers for courts 1,2, & 3

This hose has a hole in it

The master tap is hidden under a rock here. Turn it all the way on. **Don't forget** to turn it off when you have finished.
